2 x 1 MATCH CHALLENGE As has been reported earlier an Anonymous Donor has once again given our School a challenge MATCH. The Donor will match every dollar raised 1 to 2 up to \$10,000.00. So, for every \$1,000.00 raised our School gets \$500.00. We need to raise \$20,000.00 by next June 30, 2021 to get all of the \$10,000.00 Match.

The PTC Fish Fry raised a little over \$10,021.00 and will be matched with \$5,010.50. Great job! We will keep all up to date on how we are doing to make this Goal. AND many thanks to the Anonymous Donor.

The drawing will be held on May 26th, 2021, the last day of school!

ST. JOSEPH'S FINANCIAL UPDATE for the first five months (33%) of the 2020-21 Fiscal Year Parish Operating Budget follows: Income was \$40,107.50 of 88,750.00 budgeted income (45%). Expenses were \$46,831.10 of \$85,443.00 expenses (54.8%). Expenses at this time include the payment of \$11,872.00 for the driveway/parking lot/cemetery road seal coat. Great job, one and all!

ST. MICHAEL'S FINANCIAL UPDATE for the first five months (33%) of the 2020-21 Fiscal Year Parish Operating Budget follows: Income is - \$99,855.26 of \$279,554.00 budgeted income (35.1%). Expenses are - 101,630.39 of \$332,152.35 budgeted expenses (30.6%). While our percentage of Income is higher than Expenses we presently have a \$1,775.13 deficit due to projected income for the FY being \$52,598.35 less than expenses.

All are asked to prayerfully consider your Stewardship of Treasure for our Parish Ministries and to be as supportive as you are able. Thank you.

ST. MICHAEL'S CATHOLIC SCHOOL UPDATE for the first five month (33%) of the 2020-21 Fiscal Year Operating Budget follows: Income was \$149,119.97 of \$458,620.00 budgeted income (32.5%). Expenses were \$151,276.13 of \$510,310.14 budgeted expenses (29.6%). Thanks, one and all. You see our Operating Budget this year projects a deficit of \$51,690.14 but with ongoing support through Memorials, the Playhouse Raffle, Matching Funds, other Fundraising and holding down expenses we will strive to make our budget.
